Distinctions of Faith

- 1. Faith is focused on the Word
- 2. Faith <u>affirms</u> the authority to bring deliverance
- 3. Faith draws from the Lord's faithfulness
- 4. Faith <u>facilitates</u> unconditional love and steadfastness

Steadfast means to be fixed or firm in a direction or purpose – unwavering.

The word for steadfast in the original Hebrew is chesed (pronounced kheh'-sed) and it refers to God's devout loving-kindness, mercy, and faithfulness at the very core of His character and actions. God is steadfast. Therefore, His love is steadfast – unwavering, faithful, and kind.
