Key Episodes and Insights

1. Empowerment and Wisdom

- o Acts 11:24 (NIV): "He was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and faith, and a great number of people were brought to the Lord."
 - **Insight**: Barnabas's character and effectiveness in ministry were directly attributed to his being full of the Holy Spirit.

2. Divine Commissioning

- Acts 13:2-4 (NIV): "While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, 'Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.' So after they had fasted and prayed, they placed their hands on them and sent them off."
 - **Insight**: The Holy Spirit plays a crucial role in calling and sending Barnabas and Saul (Paul) for their missionary work, ensuring that their mission was divinely ordained.

3. Confrontation and Discernment

- o Acts 13:9 (NIV): "Then Saul, who was also called Paul, filled with the Holy Spirit, looked straight at Elymas and said..."
 - **Insight**: Paul, empowered by the Holy Spirit, confronts a false prophet, demonstrating the Spirit's role in providing discernment and boldness in opposition.

4. Joyful Encouragement

- Acts 13:52 (NIV): "And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit."
 - **Insight**: Despite challenges, the disciples' joy was sustained by their continuous filling with the Holy Spirit, illustrating the Spirit's role in providing emotional and spiritual strength.

5. Inclusive Gospel

- o Acts 15:8-28 (NIV): "God, who knows the heart, showed that he accepted them by giving the Holy Spirit to them, just as he did to us."
 - **Insight**: The Holy Spirit's indwelling in Gentile believers was a key sign of God's acceptance and the breaking down of cultural and religious barriers.

6. Strategic Guidance

- Acts 16:6-7 (NIV): "Paul and his companions traveled throughout the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been kept by the Holy Spirit from preaching the word in the province of Asia."
 - **Insight**: The Holy Spirit's guidance sometimes involves preventing actions to steer God's servants towards more strategic opportunities for ministry.

7. Prophetic Warnings and Directions

- o Acts 20:22-23; 28 (NIV): "And now, compelled by the Spirit, I am going to Jerusalem, not knowing what will happen to me there."
 - **Insight**: Paul's journey was marked by the Holy Spirit's compelling and warnings, which prepared him for upcoming trials and responsibilities.

8. Prophetic Intercession

- Acts 21:4 (NIV): "Finding the disciples there, we stayed with them seven days. Through the Spirit they urged Paul not to go on to Jerusalem."
 - **Insight**: The Holy Spirit not only directs but also works through the community to provide counsel and warnings.
