Read: Acts 2:42-47 (ESV)

And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. Discussion

1. Devotion to Teaching and Fellowship:

2. Signs, Wonders, and Awe:

- How did the signs and wonders performed by the apostles contribute to the growth of the Church?
- In what ways do you see God's "wonders" at work?

3. Community and Generosity:

- Why do you think the believers were selling their possessions and distributing them to meet the needs of other believers?
- How can we foster a spirit of generosity and unity in our own contexts?

4. Regular Meetings and Worship:

• The early believers met regularly, both in larger gatherings and in homes. How does regular fellowship and worship contribute to spiritual growth and unity?

5. The Lord Added to Their Number:

- Verse 47 highlights that it was the Lord who added to their number. How does recognizing God as the one who adds impact our perspective on evangelism and discipleship?
- In what ways can we partner with God in His harvesting work today?
