Many of the teachings of the New Testament are about changing our **behavior**. The fact of the matter is, changing our character is not always easy.

The cause of these issues is often referred to as **root** problems. But taking into account the new position we have in Christ as branches in the vine (tree), it makes sense that new, Godly roots are a part of that vine also.

As we see in scripture, if Jesus is the Root of Jesse
(Isaiah 11:1-10) and David (Revelation 5:5), we must
also have new roots. The needed transformation
then must take place in us as the branches, not in the
roots. Therefore God the Father is the vinedresser
who "prunes" so that we might grow in the character
and nature of Christ and bear more fruit.
