## Text: John 14:23-26

**John 14:23 NIV** Jesus replied, "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them."

- Jesus' Call for Love: Love is more than an emotion; it's an action.
- **Obedience as an Expression of Love**: True love for Jesus is demonstrated through obedience to His commands.
- **Indwelling of God**: The promise of God making a home with those who love Him.
- Experience of God's Presence: What it feels like to have God living within us.

## John 14:24 NIV

"Anyone who does not love me will not obey my teaching. These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the Father who sent me."

- Lack of Love and Obedience: The verse contrasts the earlier focus on those who love and obey Jesus with those who do not.
- Importance of Obedience in Faith: Obedience is a key indicator of one's love for Jesus and commitment to His teachings.
- **Divine Origin of Teachings**: Jesus emphasizes that His teachings are not merely His own but come from the Father.
- Understanding the Divine Authority: Recognizing the divine source of Jesus' words helps in appreciating their importance and power.

## John 14:25-26 NIV

**25** "All this I have spoken while still with you. **26** But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you."

- The Role of the Holy Spirit: Teacher, Reminder, Guide.
- The Spirit's Assistance: The Holy Spirit helps in all areas of our lives.
