Two Things That Must Occur in the Last Days (Escaton)

- 1. Rebellion and falling away within the Church
- 2. Revealing of the Man of Lawlessness (antichrist)

3 Approaches to identifying the Man of Lawlessness

- 1. Fulfilled in the first century **66-70 AD** with the fall of Jerusalem and the defilement by a Jewish rebel or Roman General (vs. 4)
- 2. Fulfilled in the early church with the appearance of false teachers after the fall of the Roman Empire. One who preached
- 3. Jesuit Priest Francisco Ribera (500-year-old teaching) The rise of a future powerful, political-religious figure.
 - Persecute and blaspheme the saints of God
 - Rebuild the temple in Jerusalem
 - Abolish the Christian religion
 - Deny Jesus Christ
 - Destroy Rome
 - Be received by the Jews
 - Pretend to be God
 - Kill the two witnesses of God
 - Conquer the world

Identifying characteristics of the Antichrist

- a. Man (vs. 3, 9)
- b. Lawless
- c. He claims to be God (vs. 4)
- d. He is born for destruction (vs. 3)
- e. Empowered by Satan (vs. 9)
- **f.** Supernatural power (vs. 9)
- g. Unparallel deception of many (vs. 10)
