Key Scriptures:

- **1 John 5:14–15:** Highlights the confidence we have in approaching God: if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.
- **Jeremiah 29:11:** Affirms God's plans for us—plans to prosper us and not to harm us, plans to give us hope and a future.
- **Matthew 6:6–13:** Jesus teaches about prayer, encouraging believers to seek God privately and providing the Lord's Prayer as a model.
- **Matthew 6:31–33:** Advises against worrying about material needs, urging believers to seek first God's kingdom and righteousness.
- **Isaiah 55:11:** Declares that God's word will not return void but will accomplish what He desires.
