There are many ways to approach prayer, but none are as effective as those that are scripturebased and Spirit-led. According to the direction Jesus gave His disciples we are to pray for the Kingdom of God to come and will of our Father to be done **"on earth as it is in heaven"** (Mt. 6:9-13). **Three aspects of fulfilling specific details of God's Kingdom are:**

 Daily bread (Mt. 6:11),
Forgiveness of sins (Mt. 6:12)
<u>Temptation</u>-free guidance and <u>deliverance</u> (Mt. 6:13).

SNATCHING POWER

"And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil." Mt. 6:13 Jesus tells us to ask God **NOT** to do something He Himself did (Matthew 4:1). As Abiders we should ask, **Why did the Holy Spirit lead Jesus to be tempted in the wilderness?** Our answer is found in Hebrews (2:14, 17-18 & 4:15-16).

From these verses we discover that Jesus took on the same flesh and blood as mankind. In order to make the devil **powerless** and make propitiation (peace) for our sins, **"He had to be made like His brethren in all things..."** ^{Heb. 2:17}

Jesus gained victory over death through the power of the resurrection. But first He gained victory over temptation through the power of **resistance** and faith in God the Father.


The answer to our question then is, **Jesus was tempted in order to defeat temptation and give victory to the tempted (Heb. 2:18).**


SNATCHED FROM EVIL

Why should we pray NOT to be lead into temptation? "Lead us not into temptation" ^{KJV} is about acknowledging, celebrating and **receiving** what Christ has already done for us. He was led into temptation by the Holy Spirit and defeated it. If we then find ourselves being tempted, it is NOT God who led us there. The devil is the one who tempts us. Therefore, we should pray, "deliver us from evil."

Hebrews 4:16 aligns perfectly with what we've learned regarding The Lord's Prayer: **"Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne** of grace [**Your Kingdom come**], so that we may receive mercy [forgive us our debts] and find grace to help in time of need [deliver us from evil]." Because of our Savior's victory, through abiding prayer we can walk in resistance, deliverance and victory over every temptation we face just as Jesus did (James 4:7).
