SHARE

Read: Acts 4:23-24 (NIV)

23 On their release, Peter and John went back to their own people and reported all that the chief priests and the elders had said to them. 24 When they heard this, they raised their voices together in prayer to God. “Sovereign Lord,” they said, “you made the heavens and the earth and the sea, and everything in them.

Statement: The Prayer Meeting should be our “Holy Reflex”. Prayer should be our first response and not our last resort.

Question: What does this passage teach us?

Read: Acts 4:25-28 (NIV)

25 You spoke by the Holy Spirit through the mouth of your servant, our father David: “Why do the nations rage and the peoples plot in vain? 26 The kings of the earth rise up and the rulers band together against the Lord and against his anointed one. 27 Indeed Herod and Pontius Pilate met together with the Gentiles and the people of Israel in this city to conspire against your holy servant Jesus, whom you anointed. 28 They did what your power and will had decided beforehand should happen.

Statement: God wastes nothing. Everything the enemy meant for evil God used for His good.

Question: How does knowing that “God wastes nothing” effect your prayers?

Read: Acts 4:29-31 (ESV)

29 Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness. 30 Stretch out your hand to heal and perform signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant Jesus.” 31 After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.

Statement: The Prayer Meeting is the place for POWER to be released.

Question: Have you ever been a part of a powerful prayer meeting? If so share what made that prayer meeting powerful.

FACTOR POINTS

Worship: When we pray on One Accord, we should expect a move of God.

Learn: We learn of the Power of God through bold prayer requests.

Serve: It pleases God when we serve him together!
