Key Scripture: Ephesian 3:17-21 (ESV)

¹⁷ so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love, ¹⁸ may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, ¹⁹ and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. ²⁰ Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, ²¹ to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

Discussion Questions:

Faith-centered prayer aligns our **mind**, **motives**, and **mouth** with God's will.

1. Mind

Verse 18 speaks about having the strength to understand God's love.

When our minds are aligned with God, our prayers become confident and faith-filled.

Discussion Questions:

- What usually fills your mind before you pray?
 - How can you pray from faith instead of fear?

2. Motives

Verse 19 shows that prayer is about knowing Christ's love, not just getting answers.

Faithful prayers come from a desire to know and love God more deeply.

Discussion Questions:

- Why do you usually pray—what are your motives?

- How can you check your heart before you pray?

3. Mouth

Verse 20 reminds us that God can do more than we can say or think.

Our words in prayer should reflect trust in God's power.

Discussion Questions:

- Are your prayers bold or limited?
- How do you speak after you've prayed?
