Key Scripture: Romans 16:25-27 (ESV)

"Now to him who is able to strengthen you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery that was kept secret for long ages but has now been disclosed and through the prophetic writings has been made known to all nations, according to the command of the eternal God, to bring about the obedience of faith—to the only wise God be glory forevermore through Jesus Christ! Amen."

Discussion Questions

1. The Mystery Now Revealed

- Paul says the gospel was once hidden but is now revealed through Christ.
- Why do you think God sometimes reveals things in His timing, not ours?
- How can prayer position us to receive God's revelation at the right time?

2. Prayer and the Nations

- The revelation is made known to *all nations*. Prayer aligns us with God's global mission.
- When you pray, do you mostly focus on personal needs, or do you also pray for God's work in the world?
- How can we expand our prayers to reflect God's heart for all people?

3. The Obedience of Faith

- Revelation leads to transformation—faith that produces obedience.
- What does it look like to move from *knowing* God's will to *living* God's will?
- Share an example of how prayer has helped you walk in obedience.

4. Glory Forevermore

- Paul closes with praise: “*to the only wise God be glory forevermore.*”
- How can prayer shift from being need-centered to being worship-centered?
- What practices help you keep God’s glory central in prayer?
