Maranatha (<u>Aramaic</u>: מרנאתא) is an <u>Aramaic phrase</u> which <u>occurs once</u> in the <u>New Testament</u> (<u>1 Corinthians 16:22)</u>

Four elements of the return of the Lord Jesus Christ

- 1. Imminent
- 2. Centered on the Person of Jesus Christ
- 3. Biblically supported
- 4. Accompanied with either judgement or reward

The continuum of the Kingdom of God is culminated at the return of the Lord Jesus Christ.

The activities of those awaiting the King's coming include:

- 1. Evangelism
- 2. Commitment to the Word of God
- 3. Intimate Worship of the King
