A NOTE FROM PASTOR

So continue to walk by faith and let's APPLY the JOY of the LORD through every trial and test for the glory of the Lord.


He's Here, He Knows, He's Able

Scripture References: Nehemiah 8:10 John 15:1-11



As New Testament believers the answer to this question is found in our relationship with Christ. In John 15:1-10, Jesus compares our relationship to Him to the lifegiving and life-changing connection between a branch and a vine. The key to this connection is ABIDING.

ABIDE: to remain, endure, continue to be present, to be held, to remain as one.

In John 15:11 Jesus then states, "These things I have spoken to you [about abiding] so that My joy may be in you, and that your joy may be made full." So how can we experience the JOY of the Lord as our strength? Let there be no doubt, it is through ABIDING in Christ. Through a lifestyle of abiding we:

1. Receive His IOY

2. Bear much fruit



When I ABIDE in Christ, I remain in Him, endure with Him, I am held by Him and I remain one in Him.

FACTORPOINT PRAYER:

Ask the Holy Spirit to lead you throughout your day into abiding opportunities that you might otherwise overlook. Trust the Lord to be with you and give you the ability to bear fruit that glorifies the Father.

Scripture References: John 4:23, Romans 12:1 Luke 24:52-53 1 Samuel 30:6-7

ABIDE: to remain, endure, continue to be present, to be held, to remain as one.

Abiding in Christ as a branch requires intentional effort. The first thing we can do to intentionally abide is to WORSHIP. Worship is an eternal activity that we can engage in right now on earth, long before we get to Heaven. As we have learned, God is unchanging and is therefore always worthy of our praise and adoration. In God, we have an everlasting reason to celebrate and walk in the IOY of the Lord.

- WORSHIP is engaging in intimacy and oneness with the lord
- WORSHIP is not limited to our feelings or our favorite Christian songs.
- WORSHIP is our direct **response** to what God the Father is searching for. (John 4:23)
- WORSHIP is an act of faith in which we offer ourselves as a living sacrifice to the Lord.



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2.3 ABIDING THROUGH LEARNING

Scripture References: Matthew 28:19 Jeremiah 15:16 Psalm 119:111 1 Chronicles 15:13-15

ABIDE: to remain, endure, continue to be present, to be held, to remain as one.

The second effort we can give to intentionally ABIDE is to **LEARN** of God's Word and ways. As disciples of Christ, we don't have to go through life unaware of God's plan for us. His Word reveals His will.

Learning God's Word is to learn of the very nature and **personality** of God Himself. Jesus and the Word (the Bible) are ONE. (John 1:1, 1:14).

- To LEARN of God's Word is to open our hearts and minds to His view and interpretation of the world.
- To LEARN of God's Word applies direct effort to knowing what God <u>desires</u> from His children in word and deed.
- To LEARN of God's Word gives us access to much-needed wisdom to walk in truth and victory in every area of our lives.



44	Your words were found and I ate them, and Your words became for me a joy and the delight of my heart; for I have been called by Your name, O Lord God of hosts.
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As I ABIDE in Christ through LEARNING, He gives me His JOY and my joy is made full.

FACTORPOINT PRAYER:

The Holy Spirit will remind you of what you have been taught. In prayer, ask the Holy Spirit to give you greater insight into the Word of God and His will for your life. Also, seek to meditate on the Word of God as led by the Holy Spirit.

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Scripture References: Psalm 100:1-2 Colossians 3:23-24 Psalm 119:111

ABIDE: to remain, endure, continue to be present, to be held, to remain as one.

The third effort we can give to intentionally ABIDE is to **SERVE** the Lord. As disciples of Christ, when we serve we are submitting ourselves as **vessels** available to God to be used as He desires and for His glory.

- When we SERVE we are actively applying and obeying the very same Word and ways of God we discover through learning.
- When we SERVE we are humbly used by God as an extension of His loving hand reaching out to those in need.
- When we SERVE we **demonstrate** that we are a part of something (The Kingdom of God) and someone (The Body of Christ, the Church), bigger than ourselves.

Shout joyfully to the Lord, all the earth. Serve the Lord with gladness; come before Him with joyful singing. -Psalm 100:1-2 NASB
