Read: Psalm 132:13-14 (CSB)

13 For the Lord has chosen Zion; he has desired it for his home: 14 “This is my resting place forever; I will make my home here because I have desired it.

Statement: God has chosen His church.

Question: When did you realize that you were chosen by God? Explain.

Read: Psalm 132:15-16 (CSB)

15 I will abundantly bless its food; I will satisfy its needy with bread. 16 I will clothe its priests with salvation, and its faithful people will shout for joy.

Statement: God will abundantly bless His people.

Question: How has God blessed you?

Read: Psalm 132:17-18 (CSB)

17 There I will make a horn grow for David; I have prepared a lamp for my anointed one. 18 I will clothe his enemies with shame, but the crown he wears will be glorious.”

Statement: He will guide His anointed through the Word.

Question: How does God’s Word guide you?
