## **REVIEW:**

**Ephesians 1** – Jesus is preeminent over all things and He is the Head of His Church.

**Ephesians 2** – Paul speaks of how God put His Church together and designed it to be a radically inclusive community.

**Ephesians 3:7** Paul begins to outline his role within the plan (much as he did in with did with the Church earlier)

- 1. Administrator vs. 2
- 2. A servant (diaconos) vs. 7 (Paul takes a superlative and makes it a comparative by saying I am the least of the least (Leaster)
- 3. A preacher (proclamatory expression primarily to the Gentiles) vs. 8
- 4. Illuminator (Not the light, but one who brought light) vs. 9

Empowerment Keys (Depicting the dual nature of the church) vs. 10-13

- 1. We display the Kingdom life both in the heavens and the earth (the angels sit amazed at how God is using His people).
- 2. We display Kingdom authority in the spiritual realm (vs. 11).
- 3. We display our Kingdom purpose through our individual and collective testimony.
