Key Scripture:

John 10:1-6 ESV – "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door but climbs in by another way, that man is a thief and a robber. 2 But he who enters by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. 3 To him the gatekeeper opens. The sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. 4 When he has brought out all his own, he goes before them, and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice. 5 A stranger they will not follow, but they will flee from him, for they do not know the voice of strangers." 6 This figure of speech Jesus used with them, but they did not understand what he was saying to them.

Key Points

- 1. The Door and the Shepherd (v.1-2):
 - o Jesus contrasts the true shepherd with thieves and robbers.
 - Question: What does the "door" symbolize?
- 2. Hearing His Voice (v.3–4):
 - The sheep follow the shepherd because they know his voice.
 - Question: How can we recognize Jesus' voice in our lives?
- 3. Strangers and Distractions (v.5):
 - Sheep flee from unfamiliar voices.
 - **Question:** What "stranger voices" do we need to avoid today?

Application

- 1. Recognize His Voice:
 - Spend time in prayer and Scripture daily.
 - o Challenge: Take 5 minutes each day to listen for God.

2. Follow His Lead:

- o Trust Jesus to guide you.
- **Question:** What step can you take to follow Him more closely this week?

3. Reject Distractions:

o Identify and remove influences that pull you from God.
