Psalm 135 and 136 are sister Psalms written by Hezekiah. It is a Psalm of progression (reflective of steps of the temple)

Vs. 4

- Behind the scene there are miracles being formed on your behalf.
- Intermediate good works (limited) and Great Wonders (eternal).
- Kindness will stop something in order to prepare something beyond what we can imagine.
- God's kindness is not ever dependent upon our recognition and praise. He simply does it because He is kind.

Vs. 5

Proverbs 3:19-27 ESV

- ¹⁹ The Lord by wisdom founded the earth; by understanding he established the heavens;
- ²⁰ by his knowledge the deeps broke open, and the clouds drop down the dew.
- 21 My son, do not lose sight of these keep sound wisdom and discretion,
- ²² and they will be life for your soul and adornment for your neck.
- ²³ Then you will walk on your way securely, and your foot will not stumble.
- ²⁴ If you lie down, you will not be afraid; when you lie down, your sleep will be sweet.
- ²⁵ Do not be afraid of sudden terror or of the ruin of the wicked, when it comes,
- ²⁶ for the Lord will be your confidence and will keep your foot from being caught.
- ²⁷ Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due when it is in your power to do.
