The Holy Spirit is the **BEGINNING** of our spiritual life. **EVERYTHING** that the Holy Spirit gives is **EXCELLENT!**

Ingredients of a Recipe of Excellence

Myrrh (gum from a tree)-It was not sliced from the tree. They took what oozed from the tree (**No help from humankind**) **The Holy Spirit is a grace gift.**

Romans 12:3, 6-8 ESV

Cinnamon

Aromatic, great **tasting**, lingering smell representing **righteousness** (versus Wormwood/sin).

Type of faith (keep wanting to taste. The Holy Spirit causes the believer to hunger and thirst for righteousness).

Calamus (Aromatic cane) **Smell**

Convicting ministry of the Holy Spirit-What draws you to the taste is the smell (e.g., praise and worship, the gospel) the Holy Spirit draws you in. This is the initial ministry of the Holy Spirit for the unbeliever (sin), and the continuous ministry of to the believer (righteousness).

Cassia (the backside of bark from a particular plant)

Very aromatic plant. It **represents the Holy Spirit's ministry to reveal Jesus Christ.**

Olive oil (located inside the olive **that was crushed**)

Represents that the Holy Spirit was given to us after Jesus went to the cross.

The Holy Spirit affirms double the value and worth - Shekel (Sanctuary Weight)

John 14:12-14 – Greater works require a greater measure [Elijah (Jesus) and Elisha (Church)] A Double portion

FACTOR POINTS

Worship: Every time I worship, the Holy Spirit aids me in lifting a sweet fragrance of thankfulness to the Father.

Learn: The Holy Spirit has come to teach me various provisions of God's goodness towards me.

Serve: The Holy Spirit reminds me that I am equipped with a double anointing to daily do the work of the Kingdom of God.
