2. **Hallowed Be Your Name (v. 9b)** – Why is it important to honor God's name in prayer? How can you do this daily?
3. **Your Kingdom Come (v. 10)** – What does it mean to seek God's will in your life rather than your own desires?
4. **Daily Bread (v. 11)** – Why does Jesus emphasize trusting God for daily needs instead of long-term security?
5. **Forgiveness (v. 12)** – How does receiving God's forgiveness challenge you to forgive others?
6. **Deliver Us from Evil (v. 13)** – Why is it important to ask for God's protection against temptation?
