- God's miracles cover ALL aspects of life (small and great).
- EVERY DAY is a miracle.
- God's kindness in the past, present and future. God has ALWAYS been kind.
- God is more than able to provide mercy. He yearns to show mercy. But it MUST BE RECEIVED.

Hebrew (*hesed*) - Loving kindness or loyal love. God commits His love by stating **I will be** your God and you will be my people.

Micah 6:8 (ESV)

He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?

Hashem demonstrates His kindness by:

- Withholding what sin says we deserve
- My praise exemplifies His acts of kindness which are from everlasting to everlasting
- Hashem is kind to **EVERY** generation (therefore, I cannot be cursed)
- Even before I was walking in the Word, the Lord was kind to me
- The ultimate act of kindness was the gift of the Word
- The Father is Kind (steadfast) for our sake versus His own
- God's care **endures FOREVER**

Factor Points

- Worship My life is an invitation for all to Worship our awesome God (Psalm 107)
- 2. **Learn** Removal of things materially has matured me spiritually **(Psalm 119:71)**
- 3. Serve Kindness towards others reflects God's kindness towards me (Galatians 5:22-23)
