YOUR MOVE

ISAIAH 58:7-8

In Isaiah 58:8, the Lord begins to tell the prophet what He would do for His people once they obeyed and fasted the way He described in verses 5-7. God wants us to know that the **prerequisite** for His movement is our obedience. Obedience is the **passcode** that unlocks the blessings that are beyond the surface.

I'M CALLING, BUT IS HE LISTENING?

ISAIAH 58:9-10

Often times we pray to God seeking an answer and leave empty handed. It is our reaction to the word that the Lord speaks that causes His ear to **receive** our cry and His voice to say "Here Am I". In other words, the **availability** of God rests on us. Our alignment with His Word not only **grabs** His attention but, it will change our current state.

HEAR - the faculty of perceiving sounds.
LISTEN - take notice of and act on what someone says; respond to advice or a request.

HE LEADS, WE FOLLOW

ISAIAH 58:11-12

Our submission to His word **reveals** that we have humbled ourselves and we are ready to receive what He wants to bestow upon us. It is God's desire for our surroundings not to affect us, but for us to thrive in the **midst** of them. There are some principles that we have replaced with traditions in the modern day church, He wants to make us restorers of the foundation when we obey. (Jeremiah 7:21-23)

THE SET APART FAST WEEK 2

JANUARY 14-20, 2019

During the second 7 days of the SET APART FAST our focus is on responding to what we have learned from Isaiah 58:8-12. Let's continue to embrace HOLINESS and the SET APART status accomplished for us by Christ.

As you pray and meditate on these verses, declare that you are who the Lord says you are. Throughout the next 7 days of fasting seek to draw closer to the Lord because of the holiness He has granted you.

DAY 1: "Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God."

-2 Corinthians 7:1

DAY 2: "[God] who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was granted us in Christ Jesus from all eternity,"

-2 Timothy 1:9

DAY 3: "Search me, O God, and know my heart; try me and know my anxious thoughts; and see if there be any hurtful way in me, and lead me in the everlasting way." **-Psalm 139:23-24**

DAY 4: "But now having been freed from sin and enslaved to God, you derive your benefit, resulting in sanctification, and the outcome, eternal life."

-Romans 6:22

DAY 5: "Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship." **-Romans 12:1**

DAY 6: "... yet He has now reconciled you in His fleshly body through death in order to present you before Him holy and blameless and beyond reproach..." **-Colossians 1:22**

DAY 7: "Do you not know that you are a temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?"

-1 Corinthians 3:16
