The Law of God

3 Assessment questions to ask:

- 1. Do you believe what I have just shared with you is true?
- 2. Is there any sin in your life that is worth going to hell over?
- 3. Can you give me a good reason why you shouldn't get right with God right now?

Romans 1:18-22

For an argument to be good it must:

- 1) Obey the laws of logic
- 2) Have statements that are more plausibly true than their denial

Example:

- 1. All men are mortal
- 2. Socrates is a man
- 3. Therefore, Socrates is mortal.

Argument #1 The Cosmological Argument

- 1. Anything that begins to exist has something that caused it to exist
- 2. The universe began to exist
- 3. Therefore, something caused the universe to exist.

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Astronomer, Physicist, Cosmologist Robert Jastrow

"For the scientist who has lived by his faith in the power of reason, the story ends like a bad dream. He has scaled the mountains of ignorance; he is about to conquer the highest peak; as he pulls himself over the final rock, he is greeted by a band of theologians who have been sitting there for centuries."

Argument #2 Fine-Tuning of the Universe

- 1. The fine-tuning of our universe is due to either: *Law, Chance* or *Design*.
- 2. It is not due to Law or Chance
- 3. Therefore, the fine-tuning of our universe is due to Design.

Gravitational Constant

Law of Gravity in mathematical form:

$F = \frac{G}{G} m^{1}m^{2}/r^{2}$

G represents an unchanging value (6.67384 × 10⁻¹¹) known as the gravitational constant

If you were to adjust the gravitational constant just 1 part in 10⁶⁰ life would be impossible ANYWHERE in the universe!

Ratio of Electrons to Protons 1:10³⁷ Gravitational Constant 1:10⁶⁰ Cosmological Constant 1:10¹²⁰ Early Universe's Low Entropy Condition 1:10¹⁰⁽¹²³⁾

- (1) Law (Physical necessity)
- (2) Chance
- (3) Design

Argument:

- 1. The fine-tuning of the universe is due to either: physical necessity, chance or Design
- 2. It is not due to physical necessity or chance
- 3. Therefore, the fine-tuning of our Universe is due to Design
