Nehemiah had favor

High official in the Persian court of King Xerxes 1
He was the King's cupbearer – it shows he had upright character

•He acquired the king's permission to return to Jerusalem and rebuild the city because it was heavy on his heart, and he had compassion for God's people

•He was given letters from the king to ensure safe passage and obtain timber from the king's forest for the gates and walls of Jerusalem

Nehemiah became the governor in the land of Judah •He did not take advantage of the food and land allotments because there was already a great burden. He made the other nobles and officials forgive all outstanding debts and ordered them to return all land and money that had been taken as taxes, so the people would be able to feed themselves and their families. They repaired and rebuilt the walls and gates in 52 days.

Nehemiah honored the Lord Compassion Sensitive to the voice of God He was obedient Man of character Man of integrity Good work ethic

And the people blessed all the men who willingly offered to live in Jerusalem.

They left their homes and land to build up the holy city. They volunteered to serve in Jerusalem.
