1. With our bodies we can contact the three-dimensional world around us. We can touch, feel, see, hear, and taste.




2. With our soul (mind, will and emotions), we are able to contact the intellectual realm. We think, feel, process, and create.





3. With our spirit we contact the spirit world, the world of the invisible. This world we are able, by faith, to bring over that which can't be seen in reality (to see).








