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

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








**GOD'S MINIMUM REQUIREMENT IS THAT: WE FORGIVE**

**Luke 17:3-10**

We are unworthy servants; we have only done our duty (When we forgive)

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# SCRIPTURES ON FORGIVENESS

## FORGIVE THOSE OFFENDING YOU:

**Mark 11:25-26**- Forgive if you have aught against any, else God won't forgive you.

**Matthew 6:14-15**-If you forgive men when they sin against you, God will also forgive you.

**Matthew 18:15-17**-Procedure for reconciliation with an offending brother.

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# SCRIPTURES ON FORGIVENESS

IF YOU HAVE OFFENDED SOMEONE:

**Matthew 5:23-24**

For God to accept your gift, you are required to go and be reconciled to your brother.

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# SCRIPTURES ON FORGIVENESS

**GOD WANTS FORGIVENESS FROM THE HEART:**

**Matthew 18:35**

You will be turned over to the tormentors if you do not forgive from your hearts.

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# SCRIPTURES ON FORGIVENESS

GOD WANTS AS MUCH FORGIVENESS AS NECESSARY:

**Matthew 18:21-22**

Forgive up to seventy times seven.

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# SCRIPTURES ON FORGIVENESS

AFTER WE HAVE GIVEN AND RECEIVED FORGIVENESS,  
GOD'S HEART IS TO FORGIVE:

**Isaiah 43:25-** "I blot out your transgression for my own sake and remember your sins no more."

**Isaiah 1:18-** "Come, let us reason together, so that your scarlet sins shall be white as snow..."

**Jeremiah 31:31-** "Put My law within them...for they shall know me... for I will forgive their iniquity and remember their sin no more."

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# SCRIPTURES ON FORGIVENESS

## GOD'S FORGIVENESS AND CLEANSING:

**1 John 1:7, 2:2**

“If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

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# DEFINING FORGIVENESS

1. TO GRANT RELIEF FROM PAYMENT.
2. TO PARDON, TO EXCUSE OFFENSE WITHOUT PENALTY.
3. TO CEASE TO FEEL RESENTMENT AGAINST THE OFFENDER.
4. TO CANCEL DEBT.
5. TO CHOOSE NOT TO HURT THOSE WHO HAVE HURT YOU.

**THIS REQUIRES AN ACT OF FAITH!**

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# FORGIVENESS

## WHAT FORGIVENESS IS NOT

- It doesn't mean that we deny or ignore the offense, saying that the offense was okay or not important.
- It doesn't mean that the offender will not be held responsible for his actions
- It doesn't mean we are required to stay in relationship with the offender

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# FORGIVENESS

## WHY FORGIVENESS IS NECESSARY

- It is non-negotiable. God requires it.
- It is the principle key that paves the way to freedom in all other ministry areas.
- It breaks the negative spiritual bond between people, releasing both sides into freedom
- The Bible tells us the consequences of not forgiving are severe.
- Humility
- Confession
- Removes the iniquity – the pressure to sin



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# TWO THINGS YOU WANT THE OFFENDER TO DO



**Take Ownership**

**"You did this to me!"**

**"You hurt me!"**

(Acknowledge it)

**Take Responsibility**

**"Take the blame for this!"**

**"Be accountable!"**

(You want the person to bear a sense of guilt, hurt, pain, remorse.)



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# 3 KEYS TO FORGIVING

1. YOU MUST RELEASE YOUR EXPECTATIONS OF OTHERS.
2. RELEASE THEM FROM OWNERSHIP/RESPONSIBILITY.

3. You must trust God in order to trust man.
