Praise is the secret to the power of God!





• We cannot come into service without and expectancy when we praise or we will come in and leave out the same way.

 God created us with a weapon inside of us that if activated by faith, humility and obedience, it will cause God to show up and show out, and that's praise!











 The characteristics of our praise to the Lord depends on the depth of our relationship with Him

 If we have built an intimate, lasting friendship with Him and have become perceptive praisers, we can expect that all these forms of praise will be part of our experience

- 3. Obedience






Praise is what attracts God's presenceweapon!











- Praise is Cod's dwelling place
- Praise is God's dwelling place
- So often we go looking for God when we could be creating an environment that invites him to come to us





We don't have to search for God in every situation

We have to praise God in every circumstance





Our human tendency to look for God is the reason there are so many different religions in the world today





 We spend so much time and effort looking for Him when all we have to do is praise

Praise is your access, your key, into the presence of God

Although God will take us as we are, there are certain qualifications to be in His presence





- •This is not to exclude anyone however there is a posture of the heart that we must have to even be in the presence of God
- •God responds to our desire for Him, but our desire must be shown in ways that meet His standards. We must be holy, as he is Holy
- God's holiness means that He is pure in motive.
- He is integrated in His thoughts, words and actions.





Satan tries to block us from the truth so that we don't praise!





These lies rob us of our confidence in **God's** word, robs us of our joy and robs us of an opportunity to connect with, and praise God

Satan doesn't want us to realize that God looks at the heart, the motives of the heart





The holiness of God means...

Being pure in motive and has very little to do with your mistakes and sin and has a lot to do with your heart.





Coming into God's presence is not something to be done casually God calls us to consecrate ourselves





Psalm 47:7

For God is the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding.





Proverbs 4:7

Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore, get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding.





3 Components

- 1. Knowledge
- 2. Understanding
- 3. Wisdom





Knowledge Facts and information





Understanding To perceive the intended meaning You can have knowledge but there may be an intended meaning that's deeper than just the facts and information and you need to get understanding





Wisdom Applied knowledge

This is now when you apply everything you have learned, you all of your knowledge to your lifestyle because you have an understanding





Praise is seeking God Worship is being found by God





The goal of praise is to create an atmosphere for the presence of God





Abraham, Moses and David were file of God because they made room for Him in their lives.

Their deep hunger to know and obey God was the basis for their relationship with Him





God shows up to genuine worshippers because they have an authentic devotion to Him and a passion for Him

Praise and worship are related but very different activities and experiences: Praise is our building a house for God, Worship is God moving in





What is worship?

- Worship is a conversation between God and man, a dialogue that should go on constantly in the life of a Christian
 - Worship is giving to God and involves a life style of giving to him the sacrifice he asks for which our lives
 - Worship is the ability to magnify God with our whole body soul and spirit





Matthew 15:8-9

These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. They worship me in vain; their teachings are merely human rules.











John 4:23

Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks.





God is seeking worshippers, those who have adopted the lifestyle of seeking Him





What does it mean to seek?

Seeking the Lord means seeking his presence.

"Presence" is a common translation of the Hebrew word "face."

Literally, we are to seek his "face." But this is the Hebraic way of having access to God.

To be before his face is to be in his presence.











God responds to those who have a deep hunger for Him





Psalm 42:1-2-As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for you, my God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When can I go and meet with God?

We have to want God!

If we want God as bad as we say we do, we will step outside of our comfort zones for the sake of obedience

We all want to be with God!





Deep is the hunger and thirst of these committed ones that seek God until they are caught by Him. Their passion for Him will not allow them to stop until they gain the One for whom they reach. Hours spent in prayer and praise are the rule for them, not the exception





This attitude is uncommon in the church. We are much too comfortable to expend the effort such a passion requires






Why? One possible answer is because we have yet to experience the beauty and power of God's manifested presence

The reward of our seeking us worth every bit of our effort, and more











We cannot seek Him with all our heart because there are too many things that pull our attention away from Him











The children of Israel were about to enter the Promised Land, Joshua recounted all that God had done for them and challenged them to choose whom they would serve.





Joshua 24:15

But if serving the Lord seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve...But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord





Joshua 24:16b-18

Far be it from us to forsake the Lord to serve other gods! It was the Lord our God Himself who brought us and our fathers up out of Egypt, from that land of slavery, and performed those great signs before our eyes....We too will serve the Lord, because He is our God



Joshua 24:23

Throw away the foreign gods that are among you and yield your hearts to the Lord, the God of Israel

In other words, he told them to make themselves qualified for serving God.





We cannot keep the idols of our heart and expect to receive the gift of His presence.

Repentance is, therefore, an essential ingredient of seeking and praising Him.

We must return to Him on a daily basis, so He can turn to us.





His coming to us is predicated on the fact that we get rid of all the obstacles that keep us from coming to Him.




















Those who know Your name will trust in You, for You, Lord, have never forsaken those who seek You





Trust is a necessity if we are to genuinely see and praise the Lord.

Otherwise, we will take matters into our own hands when we don't like what is happening in our life or we don't understand the path God has set before us.





David did so much in His life but God called him " A man after His own heart" not because he had it all together but because David would seek God until He found Him





God is searching for such a generation, a people who will value His presence over their own selfish desires and wait for His purposes despite long periods of preparation.





Such a generation will approach Him with humility, subjecting their pride-filled hearts to the searching of His eyes.

They will value Him and His plans for them above all else





Psalm 14:2

The Lord looks down from heaven on the sons of men to see if there are any who understand, any who seek God













This is the bottom line of praise and worship.





1 Chronicles 28:9

And you, my son Solomon, acknowledge the God of your father, and serve Him with wholehearted devotion and with a willing mind, for the Lord searches every heart and understands every motive behind the thoughts. If you seek Him, He will be found by you; but if you forsake Him, He will reject you forever



Praise and seek God with all your heart. Then wait and see what He will do in your life He will grace you with His presence.





Worship is what praise is all about: Seeking God until He graces us with His presence. Once He is present, everybody and everything else is dismissed.





Finding God and enjoying His presence is the sole purpose of our praise.

Only then may we know what to do and how to live effectively.
