*The tension of acknowledging Jesus' abilities but **diminishing His identity**:*

“Where did this man get this wisdom and these miraculous powers?” they asked. ⁵⁵“Isn’t this... v54-55

*The reluctance to move beyond **preconceived ideas about Jesus**:*

“Isn’t this **the carpenter’s son**? Isn’t his mother’s name Mary, and aren’t his brothers James, Joseph, Simon and Judas? ⁵⁶ Aren’t all his sisters with us? Where then did this man get all these things?” ⁵⁷ And they took offense at him.

*The reluctance to move beyond **past experiences with Jesus**:*

Then Jesus entered a house, and again a crowd gathered, so that he and his disciples were not even able to eat. ²¹ When his family heard about this, they went to take charge of him, for they said, **“He is out of his mind.”**

*The reluctance to move beyond **personal expectations of Jesus**:*

Jesus’ brothers said to him, “Leave Galilee and go to Judea, so that your disciples there may see the works you do. ⁴ No one who wants to become a public figure acts in secret. **Since you are doing these things, show yourself to the world.**” ⁵ For even his own brothers did not believe in him.
