We experience soul satisfaction through relationship with Jesus.

You're not too good to be true...

The Presence & Activity of the Holy Spirit:

The Holy Spirit's presence & activity is a gift of grace.

By this he meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were later to receive. Up to that time the Spirit had not been **given**, since **Jesus had not yet been glorified**. v39

The Holy Spirit's presence & activity is a gift of grace—unfortunately, we can grieve, extinguish, and resist Him and what He's doing.

Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. <sup>30</sup> And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. <sup>31</sup> Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. <sup>32</sup> Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. Ephesians 4:29-32

Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always strive to do what is good for each other and for everyone else. <sup>16</sup> Rejoice always, <sup>17</sup> pray continually, <sup>18</sup> give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. <sup>19</sup> Do not quench the Spirit. <sup>20</sup> Do not treat prophecies with contempt <sup>21</sup> but test them all; hold on to what is good, <sup>22</sup> reject every kind of evil.
