The heart is deceitful above all things,

Self-deception is the place where we start, but it doesn't have to be the place we stay. Self-deception is a place where it's easy to linger in, but it doesn't have to be the place we live from.

¹² For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the basic principles of *the oracles of God*. You need *milk*, not *solid food*, ¹³ for everyone who lives on *milk* is unskilled in *the word of righteousness*, since he is a child. ¹⁴ But *solid food* is for the mature, for those who have their powers of discernment trained by constant practice to *distinguish good from evil*.
