What it doesn't mean:

These people honor me with their lips, <u>but</u> their hearts are far from me. Matthew 15:8

Don't replace following Jesus with bible reading.

Permanence

Ownership

Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, <u>be filled with the Spirit</u>, ¹⁹ speaking to one another with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit. Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord, ²⁰ always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Occupying Potency

To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the <u>glorious riches</u> of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.
