I. Romans 10:1-5

- A. <u>V1</u> That Israel may "BE" saved? It doesn't say that they may "GET" saved.
 - 1. Saved v sozo which means to rescue, save, deliver, heal, make whole
 - 2. **Saved** *n sōtēria* It is a "state or a condition" of being rescued, being in safety, being in deliverance, being in health, being in wholeness
 - a) We don't just need Saved, we need the Savior, we don't just need healed, we need the Healer, we don't just need delivered, we need the Deliverer.
 - b) <u>Ephesians 2:8–9 (NKJV)</u> 8 For <u>by grace</u> you have been <u>saved through faith</u>, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works, lest anyone should boast.
 - (1) **By grace** charis Goodwill, favor and resources freely disseminated by God
 - (2) You have been saved sōzō To rescue, save, deliver, heal, make whole
 - (3) Through dia Means by which

B. <u>V2</u> - Zeal without knowledge

- 1. <u>Bear witness</u> marturĕō To assert or offer authentication or direct knowledge
- 2. **Zeal** zēlŏs To have a deep devotion or excessive fervor to something
- 3. **Knowledge** ĕpiginōs Personal acquaintance with, full discernment
 - a) Galatians 1:13-14
 - b) Matthew 26:3–4

C. <u>V3-5</u> - Ignorant of God's righteousness and establishing their own

- 1. **Ignorant** agnŏĕō To not know, with the implication of a lack of information or lack of recognition of available information
- 2. **Establish** *histēmi* To put in force, to enact or authorize
- 3. <u>Righteousness</u> *dikaiŏsunē* Satisfy the moral requirements of God; doing what God requires; God's ways of being in right standing with Him
- 4. **Submitted** *hupŏtassō* To obey or be under obedience; put under control of or in submission to
 - a) Philippians 3:9
 - b) **Galatians 3:21–26**
- 5. **Galatians 3:6 (NKJV)** 6 just as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.

D. Acts 4:5-13

- 1. Has been made well v sozo To rescue, save, deliver, heal, make whole
- 2. **Salvation** *n sōtēria* A "state or a condition" of being rescued, being in safety, being in deliverance, being in health, being in wholeness
- 3. **Be saved** *v* sozo To rescue, save, deliver, heal, make whole
- 4. **Boldness** *parrhēsia* Courage to face difficulty or danger with honest and straightforward attitude and speech
- 5. <u>Uneducated</u> agrammatŏs Not formal, authorized education in Hebrew Rabbinical traditions
- 6. <u>Untrained</u> *idiōtēs* A person who has not acquired systemic information or expertise in some field of knowledge or activity
