- I. <u>Ex 29:38</u> PREPARING A DWELLING PLACE REQUIRES:
 - A. OFFERING our hearts & lives in worship to Him
 - B. SACRIFICE Denying ourselves to be a living SACRIFICE for Jesus!
 - C. CONSISTENCY CONSISTENT; steadfast, immovable, and always abounding
 - 1. **Continually** *tâmîyd* Constantly, regularly, perpetually (never stopping)
- II. Ex 29:42 CONTINUATION God doesn't want it to stop with us
 - A. Continual burnt offering throughout your generations:
 - 1. **Continual** *tâmîyd* Constant, regularly, perpetual
 - 2. Throughout lô' To, towards, to the point; toward a goal
 - 3. **Generations** dôwr Lineage, family line
 - B. Proverbs 22:6 (NKJV) Train up your child
 - 1. <u>Train</u> *chânak* To narrow, initiate or discipline, dedicate; develop a behavior by instruction and practice.
 - a) Matthew 7:14 (NKJV) 14 Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.
 - (1) **Narrow** stěnos Restricted, confined, not much room
 - (2) <u>Difficult</u> thlibō Suffer trouble, persecution, hardship, pressure, oppression
 - C. Deuteronomy 4:9 (NKJV) Teach your children and grandchildren
 - 1. <u>Take heed</u> shâmar To guard, protect, preserve; attentive & focused on
 - 2. **<u>Diligently</u>** m^e od Vehemence; forceful energy, passionate energy
 - 3. Teach yâda Reveal; Cause to be known through instruction and experience
 - D. <u>Deuteronomy 11:18–21 (NKJV)</u>
 - E. **Psalm 128:1-6 (NKJV)**
 - F. Isaiah 54:13-14 (NKJV)
 - G. Acts 2:38-39 (NKJV)

- III. Ex 29:42-43 At the tabernacle of meeting; I will meet you and speak with you!
 - 1. Meet yâ ad To fix upon, to come near, approach
 - 2. Hebrews 10:24-25 (NKJV) Not forsaking the assembly
 - a) Stir up parŏxusmŏs Stimulate, motivate, encourage, incite, provoke
 - b) Forsaking ĕgkatalĕipō Leave behind, to cease or stop an activity
 - c) Assembling ĕpisunagōgē To gather together, meet in one place
 - B. V43 Sanctified by My glory
 - 1. Sanctified qâdôsh Sacred; dedicated to service and loyalty to God; set apart
 - 2. **Glory** *kâbôd* Weight; splendor, honor, majesty, abundance, manifestation of presence and power
 - 3. 2 Chronicles 7:1–3 (NKJV) Glory of the LORD fills the house
 - C. V44 Consecrate Aaron and his sons
 - 1. Consecrate qâdôsh To be set apart; holy, sacred, dedicated
 - 2. Colossians 3:23-24 (NKJV)
 - 3. Ezekiel 44:10-17 Minister to the LORD
 - D. V45 I will dwell with them
 - 1. **<u>Dwell</u>** shâkan To inhabit, live in, abide or rest in; remain, camp, make a home
 - E. <u>V46</u> They shall know
 - Know yâda Reveal; Cause something to be known through instruction and experience
 - a) Philippians 3:10-11 (NKJV) That I may know Him
