- A. 5 Phases of Preparing a Personal Dwelling Place with God:
 - 1. Enter The Door
 - 2. Engage The Meeting
 - 3. Encounter The Glory
 - 4. Evacuate The Consecrating
 - 5. **Endure** The Dwelling

B. 5 Phases of Preparing A Personal Dwelling Place with God:

- 1. V42 Phase 1 Enter Through The Door
 - a) <u>Door</u> *pethach* The opening, portal or entrance way in and out of a space; access point; where you enter or leave an area
 - (1) John 10:9–10 (NKJV) Jesus said, 9 *I am the door*
 - b) Jesus is the door or entryway into the Kingdom of God
 - (1) <u>John 3:3–6 (NKJV)</u> Unless one is born again, he cannot see or enter the kingdom of God. (System or way of God; kingdom way of doing things)
 - c) What is the door practically for us?
 - (1) John 1:1-3 (NKJV) The Door is Jesus, Jesus is the Word
- 2. V42 Phase 2 Engage Meeting
 - a) Meet lô' To, towards, to the point; toward a goal
 - (1) Proverbs 4:20–22 (NKJV) 20 My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings.
 - b) Engage Entangle, interlock or mesh with
 - (1) What we engage determines what we will experience
 - c) Hebrews 11:6 (NKJV) But without faith it is impossible to please Him
 - d) Romans 10:17 (NKJV) 17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
- 3. <u>V43</u> <u>Phase 3</u> <u>Encounter</u> <u>Glory</u>
 - a) 1 Corinthians 3:16 (NKJV) You are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?
 - b) Sanctified gâdôsh Sacred; set apart, dedicated to service and loyalty to God
 - c) **Glory** *kâbôd* Weight; splendor, honor, majesty, abundance, manifestation of presence and power

	(1) Baptize - baptizō - To immerse, sink, overwhelm, flood, soak, dip
g)	Acts 1:4-8 (NKJV) You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come
	upon you
	(1) Power - dunamis - Force, miraculous ability, might, strength; Possession of
	controlling influence; the potentiality to exert force in performing some
	function
	(2) Come - ěpěrchŏmai - Arrive, overtake, influence

d) Colossians 1:27 (NKJV) - Christ (the Word) in you, the hope of glory.
