- 3. When have you had to wait a long time for God's promise to come to pass? How did you cope? What made it hard? What helped you persevere in hope?
- 4. Why did Sarah suggest Abraham sleep with Hagar? What was Sarah trying to achieve through this?
- 5. What were the short-term results of this? What longer term implications and results did this have?
- 6. Have you ever, like Sarah, tried to speed up the fulfilment of God's promise to you? How did you attempt this? What happened?
- 7. What helps you wait? What do we learn through waiting?
- 8. When you look back on your life, where do you see God moving to fulfil his promises where perhaps, at the time, you didn't? What changed your perspective?
- 9. Read Romans 8:28. When have you experienced this for yourself?
- 10. How have you learnt to accept God's timing rather than your own?

- Pray for the two families from Afghanistan here.
- Pray for the people of Morocco (earthquake) and Libya (flooding).
