Read John 21:1-25

5. Why did Peter go fishing? How was this a response to his crisis?
6. How does this fishing trip correspond to the original call Jesus made to Peter?
7. How did Jesus restore Peter? What did he do? Why did he do it this way?
8. What does a follower do? What does it mean to be a follower? What does this look like?
9. What does the call of Jesus require of us?
10. How have you experienced the call of Jesus in your life lately?
11. What was your "Then feed my sheep" moment? What happened? How did Jesus restore you from your stumble?
12. How do we track of where Jesus is moving and what he is doing?
