- 1. In the bible what purpose do dreams and visions often serve?
- 2. Why do you think the imagery of Daniel's dream is so strange? What does this mean Daniel must do?
- 3. What has Daniel's experience of dreams been so far in the book? What is different about this one?
- 4. What does "beast" make you think of? What qualities does a beast have?
- 5. What qualities can you see of these beasts from their descriptions?
- 6. Why do you think that these kings are described in this way?
- 7. Who is the one like the son of man? Why is he called by this title? What does the title mean?
- 8. What key lesson do we learn in this book about the kingdoms of the world? How is God's kingdom contrasted with man's?
- 9. Why does Daniel have to ask for the meaning of the dream? How do you think this made him feel?
- 10. What does this passage teach us about God, about man, and about the world we live in?
- 11. How important is it to have an eternal perspective? How will having an eternal perspective help you resist temptation?
- 12. What should our attitude be toward the world?

- Pray for the plight of refugees, the homeless, and the displaced around the world.
- Pray for the two families from Afghanistan soon to be arriving with us.
- Pray for those affected by violence and conflict around the globe.
