Romans 8:18-39

Read Romans 8:18-39

- 1. How is conservation of the environment part of our calling to follow Jesus? Why is this so?
- 2. Why does Paul use the image of childbirth in this passage? What point does this make?
- 3. Why is it important that we enter into the struggles we see in this world?
- 4. What is our vocation? What have we been created for? What does God expect from us in this situation?
- 5. Where do you see brokenness in the world around you?
- 6. How is God calling you to enter into the world's brokenness?
- 7. How does the Spirit help us to pray and help us know what to pray for? Why is this?
- 8. What part do we have to play in the restoration and renewal of this world?
- 9. What are your experiences of finding God in the struggles of this broken world we inhabit?
- 10. What is Paul's point in verses 28-29? What does it mean to be conformed to the image of Jesus in our relationship with the world?
- 11. If you rewrote the list in verses 38-39 what are the things that you might write down that you sometimes think might separate you from God? Why?
- 12. How are you working to reveal God's transforming power in the world at the moment?

Prayer points:

- Continue to pray for the people of Indonesia.
- Pray for whatever it is right now that God is calling you to be a part of changing in his world.
