Read Genesis 1

1. What does this passage tell us about the nature of creation and God's relationship to it?
2. What do we learn about our relationship with creation?
3. What expectations does God have for his creation? What purpose does it have?
4. What are God's expectations of us? What role are we to play?
5. What part of God's creation grabs you, makes you feel most connected? Why?
6. What does it mean to care for creation? Why is it important? What does this look like everyday for you?
7. What issues are facing creation today? How do we address these issues in a way fitting for followers of Jesus?

Read Colossians 1:15-17

8. What is the relationship between Jesus and creation? What is his role?
9. How does the life and person of Jesus direct and inform how we respond to the world around us?
10. What issues of creation care are you actively engaging in in your life?

Prayer points:

- Spend time praying for the situation in Israel/Palestine and the people affected by the conflict.
- Pray for the people of Taiwan still trapped after the earthquake.
- Pray for the recently arrived family from Afghanistan.
