## **Read John 20:19-22**

1. How would you describe the disciples' faith at this point in time?
2. What was Jesus' first words to them? Why do you think he said this?
3. What larger theological point do these words have? Why do you think this is significant?
4. Where does verse 21 tell us mission starts? Why is it crucial for us to remember this?
5. "Mission is finding out what God is doing and joining in." What do you think of this statement? How are you joining in?
6. What does such a mission require from us? What sort of faith is needed for such a task?
7. What gift does Jesus offer? What role does this gift play in growing and strengthening our faith?
8. What missional step of faith is God calling you to make? How will you do this?
9. How does God's call to Abram resonate with the calling Jesus issues to his disciples (and us) here?
10. What does it mean for you to be sent to others at this time? Who and where are your 'others'?

## Prayer points:

- Pray for the plight of refugees, the homeless, and the displaced around the world.
- Pray for the two families from Afghanistan here.
- Pray for those affected by violence and conflict and climate change around the globe.
