- 4. Why did Barak want to go only with Deborah? What different reasons do you think he might have had? What did this show about his character?
- 5. Have there been times when your faith has wavered or weakened? What happened? What did you learn from those times?
- 6. What do you think of what Jael did? Why? What would you have done?
- 7. In what ways do Barak and Deborah show great faith in this episode?
- 8. What does this episode tell us about the way God works? How have you experienced God working like this in your life?
- 9. What is it that helps faith endure? What is it that has helped your faith endure over time?
- 10. What is God laying before you at this time? What is he calling you to step into?
