Read Exodus 13:17-22 and 16:1-8

- 1. What do you know of the Exodus story? What are the key episodes in the Hebrews' escape from Egypt?
- 2. How did the Hebrews fail to trust in God's power?
- 3. What were the consequences for them of this failure?
- 4. What was the point of the ten plagues God visited upon the Egyptians? What should the Hebrews have learnt through these demonstrations?
- 5. Why did the Hebrews grumble (16:3)? What do you think would have happened if they hadn't behaved this way?
- 6. How did God provide for the Hebrews?
- 7. How has God provided for you in past times of need?
- 8. How do we try to provide for ourselves? What problems come with this?
- 9. How were the Hebrews to trust in God's presence? What did this mean?
- 10. "God doesn't give us a map because he wants to be our guide." What do you think of this statement? Have you experienced this for yourself?
- 11. What is God asking you to do at the moment? What is the thing he is calling you to step out into next?
- 12. How will you trust God for his power, provision and presence in this next step? What will this look like practically?

Prayer points:

- Pray for greater trust in God's power, provision and presence.
- Pray for the ill and vulnerable in our communities.
- Pray for those affected by violence and conflict around the globe.
