- 4. What did the disciples do after the Spirit came upon them? Why?
- 5. Do you think the disciples knew what was about to happen? Why or why not?
- 6. What is the role and purpose of the Holy Spirit?
- 7. How is this role being fulfilled in your life and in your community today?
- 8. What did the disciples 'commit themselves to'? Why these things? What do we learn about God's people through this?
- 9. What reactions were there from the crowd?
- 10. "Often the Spirit does unexpected things." When has the Holy Spirit surprised you? What was the result?
- 11. How do we be obedient to what Spirit prompts in us?
- 12. How is the Holy Spirit a gift to the church as a body? Why is this so important?
