Read Hebrews 12:18-29

- 1. How would you characterise the picture of God in verses 18-20?
- 2. How is God's presence described here? Why would his presence be experienced like this?
- 3. What is holiness? What does "God is holy" actually mean?
- 4. How is Mount Zion described? What contrast is there with Mount Sinai? What does this contrast signify?
- 5. What does the fact that God is holy mean for us?
- 6. What encounters with the holiness of God do you remember from the Hebrew bible?
- 7. What is the effect of God's holiness on us?
- 8. How are we a holy people? How has this happened? What makes it possible?
- 9. Based on our journey through the book of Hebrews so far, how would you explain what Jesus has done to make us holy and acceptable to God?
- 10. Which of the two mountains are you presenting to other people? How are you doing this?
- 11. How do we make sure we invite people to Zion rather than Sinai? Why is this important?
