5. What next step of prayer is God looking for from you?
6. Why did Saul and co. go to Cyprus?
7. “God will turn up in your relational world, on your relational pathways.” Why is this a crucial thing for us to understand?
8. What should our response today be to false prophets, especially in front of the people being led astray by them?
9. Why is Sergius Paulus such a key person here?
10. What does this connection to Paulus end up leading to?
11. How can you be more intentional in seeking opportunities to disciple others and be discipled by others?
