## Read Joshua 2

1. What was Rahab risking in aiding the Israelite spies?
2. Why did she decide to help the spies? How do you think Rahab's outlook on life had changed in order for her to decide to do this?
3. How did Rahab come to believe in the power of Israel's God? What would she be basing her belief on?
4. How did Rahab act upon her faith in Israel's God? What does this say about the connection between faith and action?
5. What do you think life as a prostitute would have been like for Rahab?
6. What does God's love and provision for Rahab tell us about who God is and who he cares for?
7. What does Rahab's story reveal to us of God's heart for the poor?
8. How did Jesus interact with prostitutes in his ministry? How did he behave towards them? What did he say?
9. What is God calling his church to do to combat human trafficking and sexual slavery?
10. What role is God calling you to play in ending modern slavery?
