- 4. How did Rahab act upon her faith in Israel's God? What does this say about the connection between faith and action?
- 5. What do you think life as a prostitute would have been like for Rahab?
- 6. What does God's love and provision for Rahab tell us about who God is and who he cares for?
- 7. What does Rahab's story reveal to us of God's heart for the poor?
- 8. How did Jesus interact with prostitutes in his ministry? How did he behave towards them? What did he say?
- 9. What is God calling his church to do to combat human trafficking and sexual slavery?
- 10. What role is God calling you to play in ending modern slavery?
