- 5. How are we pressured into bowing down in this way?
- 6. What practices did the three friends have in their lives that would have helped them in this situation?
- 7. What/who do you think the fourth figure in the furnace was? Why? What does the presence of this fourth figure tell us?
- 8. Why do we face and experience pain and suffering?
- 9. What is God's response to pain and suffering?
- 10. How has God reminded you that, even in the midst of pain and suffering, he is with you?
- 11. How does our faith grow? What is it that helps you place more faith and trust in God?
- 12. What have been the events/experiences/times when your own faith has experienced a significant 'growth spurt'? Why do you think this was?

- Pray for the ill and vulnerable in our communities.
- Pray for those affected by violence and conflict around the globe.
