- 1. What does Paul chastise the Athenians for? Why?
- 2. What does Paul commend them for? Why do you think he does this?
- 3. How does Paul define God? Why do you think he chooses this definition?
- 4. Today, in what ways do we "cover all options" like the Athenians did?
- 5. What Idols would Paul see if he walked around Christchurch today? Where do we/our society "worship"?
- 6. Where does Paul say God is seen most clearly?
- 7. Where does Paul say the Athenians can see God?
- 8. What promises does Paul make to the Athenians about God and his actions?
- 9. How would you sum up in a few sentences the story of creation and history, the "greatest story ever told"?
- 10. Did your answer to question 9 include reference to/examples of all four of our key relationships (God, Self, Each Other, World)? If so, in what way? If not, what could you change in order to include them?
- 11. Spend time sharing ways in which "The 'E' Word" series has inspired you, changed you, or altered your perspective on evangelism.
