## Read Romans 7:1-6

- 1. What does Paul say about sin? Why is sin such a problem?
- 2. What is Paul talking about in verse 6? Why is this important?
- 3. What does Paul say about the law? Why does he say this? How do we use the law against others? Why do we use it to judge others?
- 4. Why was the law given to the Jewish people? What was its purpose?
- 5. What does it mean that we have died to the law through the body of Christ?
- 6. How is Jesus the answer to this issue? How does he free us from a life dominated by law and sin and death?
- 7. When we look at Jesus what do we see? How is this a blueprint for us?
- 8. How have our sinful passions been overcome? How is this evident in your life?
- 9. What are we free from? What has God rescued us from? How has this changed things for us?
- 10. What are we free for? What purposes does God have for those he sets free?
- 11. "We want to listen to what God is doing in the world. We want to see where God is leading us." How are you doing this in your life at the moment?
- 12. How is our freedom related to the freedom of others? Why is freedom not just something for us individually?
