- 7. How have we misunderstood what leadership should look like?
- 8. What is leadership? What are the characteristics of the leadership Jesus offered us?
- 9. What was God's way of redeeming the mess we have made?
- 10. What do verses 9-10 say about what made Jesus the perfect leader? Why was this important?
- 11. What does verse 11 tell us about how we should view others?
- 12. What stops us seeing others as made in the image of God? Who are the people our world sees as less equal and less worthy than others?
- 13. How are you using your position and voice to honour and love people not usually seen as worthy of honour and love?
